TUESDAY – Distillery Roner

Immerse yourself in the magical world of distillation

Let yourself be seduced by Master Distiller Helmut Oberhofer one day in the fascinating world of distillation. For more than 60 years full-bodied fruit distillates, elegant grappa and fruity liqueurs are produced in the distillery Roner. In production, we attach great importance to the tradition from decades of experience of the Roner family, but we are still looking for new opportunities for us, to continue to improve.

You'll get an unique insight into the making of our spirits with our master distiller and learn how 8 kg of pears fit in a bottle, what the castle ruins of Caldifff has to do with our apple distillate and the way in which we age it. Maybe we also tell you the secret of how the pear get into the bottle.

At the tasting you can listen to the explanations of our master distiller and you will embark together on a journey for your senses into the diverse world of grappa and distillates. Finally, we end the visit with a lunch.



WEDNESDAY – Cantina Tramin

Welcome party in the foyer of Cantina Tramin, introduction to the cooperative and guided tour of the winery, which was restructured in 2010 by architect Werner Tscholl.

Winemaker Willi Stürz will present interesting facts about Gewürztraminer: the diversity of soils and vineyards, the various typicities and vintage-related differences which can then be experienced directly in the glass.

The fascinating facets of this wine as an accompaniment to food will be demonstrated by the wines of Cantina Tramin at lunch in the light-flooded Nussbaumer Panorama Room.



THURSDAY- Winery Hofstätter

The truth lays in the vineyard

To truly understand why a wine tastes the way it does, one must explore its vineyard. For this reason Martin Foradori Hofstätter will guide you personally on a tour* of three of the estate's best sites and acquaint you with the soils, the climatic attributes, and authentic charm of the Alto Adige landscape. Unique for a family winery in South Tyrol, the estate possesses vineyards on both sides of the Adige River.

The wines will be tasted in their very origins to trace the characteristics of their source and grape variety.

The historic Barthenau Estate shall open its gates for the "Traminer Feast for the Senses" to share specialties of Alto Adige and celebrate the unique wine village of Tramin.

*in the case of bad weather, the tasting will take place at the winery in Tramin.



FRIDAY – Guided tour trough Tramin

Guided tour through the historical town centre of Tramin where you can experience the millenary history of this wine village. Visit the old wine farms with their typical cellars and discover interesting stories about the country and its people, the local architecture as well as the culture and tradition of Tramin.
